### Supervision charge

Victorian gaming venue operators are required to pay a supervision charge to recover the costs of gaming industry regulation and will be invoiced annually.

Application for approval of an associate of a gambling industry participant (natural person)	\$101.00
Application for approval of an associate of a gambling industry participant (any other case)	\$525.60

Note: The above fees do not apply when the associate application is being lodged with an application for a new gambling industry participant licence. They also do not apply when lodged with an application for renewing a bingo centre operator, registered bookmaker, commercial raffle organiser or venue operator licence.
